BEGINNING FLY FISHING - Room 150

TOM REISDORF HAS BEEN FLY FISHING SINCE 1966. HE GREW UP FISHING IN THE ADIRONDACK MOUNTAINS OF UPSTATE NY. AND WAS A FORMER STATE CHAIRMAN

OF THE VIRGINIA COUNCIL OF TROUT UNLIMITED, AND FORMER FLY FISHING AND FLY TYING INSTRUCTOR FOR THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND INLAND FISHERIES AND "BECOMING AN OUTDOORS WOMAN PROGRAM". HE IS THE FORMER MANAGER OF ANGLER'S LANE AND STILL WORKS THERE PART TIME. HE HAS GUIDED CLIENTS FOR TROUT AND SMALLMOUTH BASS AROUND VIRGINIA FOR DECADES. BEGINNING FLY FISHING WILL CONSIST OF LEARNING ABOUT RODS, REELS, FLY LINES, LEADERS, TIPPETS, BACKING AND BASIC KNOTS. THEN LEARNING ABOUT WHAT IS IN A FLY VEST OR PACK, FLY BOXES AND FLIES, GADGETS, ETC. A CASTING SESSION WILL FINISH THE CLASS.

ELK IN VIRGINIA & MULE DEER HUNTING -

AVID ELK HUNTER, **MIKE ROBERTS** HAS DEVOTED HIS ENTIRE LIFE TO NATURE. HE IS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE WOODS, WATERS, AND WILDLIFE EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION. MIKE CURRENTLY SERVES AS A NATURALIST FOR THOMAS ROAD OUTPOST. MIKE KNOWS MANY HUNTERS HAVE DREAMED OF ONE DAY HARVESTING A MAJESTIC ELK OR MULE DEER. IT HAS BECOME OVERWHELMING AND DIFFICULT TO NAVIGATE THE OPTIONS AVAILABLE FOR SOMEONE TO BEGIN PLANNING AN ELK OR MULE DEER HUNT. THIS SEMINAR WILL DISCUSS THE REINTRODUCTION OF ELK INTO VIRGINIA AND MIKE'S TIPS AND TRICKS FOR HUNTING BOTH ELK AND MULE DEER.

INTRO TO BASIC PISTOL - Room 170

TRACI CAMPBELL IS A NRA CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR FOR CONCEALED WEAPONS CLASSES. THIS CLASS WILL COVER MOST OF THE BASIC FIREARMS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING SHOOTING FUNDAMENTALS. AS WELL AS BUILDING A PERSONAL PROTECTION PLAN AND THE LEGAL USE OF FORCE. YOU WILL LEAVE WITH AN UNDERSTANDING OF VIOLENT ENCOUNTERS AND THEIR AFTERMATHS AS WELL AS A BRIEF OVERVIEW OF VIRGINIA CARRY LAWS. **A SECOND CLASS INCLUDING RANGE TIME WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE A CERTIFICATION IS OFFERED.** THIS INITIAL CLASS IS FREE OF CHARGE, THE SECOND CLASS, INCLUDING RANGE TIME, WILL BE OFFERED AT A LATER TIME TO GAIN A CERTIFICATION AT A COST OF \$75 THROUGH, TRACI CAMPBELL. THE FIREARMS CLASS CERTIFICATION CAN BE GIVEN TO ANYONE OVER 12 YEARS OLD.
